Primary 4 Term 4 Focus For Learning: Literacy

Reading

This term, the children will develop their understanding of fiction texts through analysing and evaluating the shared text Charlie and the Chocolate Factory: The Play. They will investigate and appreciate this text by discussing the complex ideas, structures and specialist vocabulary surrounding the text.

Spelling and Handwriting

The children will work on their personal, differentiated phoneme and common word spelling lists, with a focus on being able to spell familiar words correctly within a range of writing contexts. The children will also be encouraged and supported to use correct letter formation and pencil grip when writing.

<u>Writing</u>

This term, children will be asked to continue to focus on using correct punctuation and grammar in their written work (especially full stops and capital letters). We will focus on the following writing genres:

- Recount
- Explanation

Talking and Listening

This term, the children will have the opportunity to research a topic of their choice and present their learning to their classmates through a **solo talk in the week beginning Monday 7th June**. Further details will be provided closer to the time.

Primary 4 Term 4 Focus For Learning: Mathematics and Numeracy

Measurement

Children will be able to estimate how long or heavy an object is, or what amount it holds, using everyday things as a guide, then measure or weigh it using appropriate instruments and units.

Success of these learning targets will be indicated by the following:

- Children will use their knowledge of everyday objects to provide reasonable estimates of length, height, mass and capacity.
- Children will make accurate use of a range of instruments including rulers, metre sticks, digital scales and measuring jugs when measuring lengths, heights, mass and capacities using the most appropriate instrument for the task.
- Children will record measurements of length, height, mass and capacity to the nearest standard unit, for example, millimetres (mm), centimetres (cm), grams (g), kilograms (kg), millilitres (ml), litres (l).

Fractions

Having explored fractions by taking part in practical activities, children will show their understanding of: how a single item can be shared equally; the notation and vocabulary associated with fractions; and where simple fractions lie on the number line.

Success of these learning targets will be indicated by the following:

- Children can explain what a fraction is using concrete materials, pictorial representations and appropriate mathematical vocabulary.
- Children can demonstrate understanding that the greater the number of equal parts, the smaller the size
 of each share.
- Children can use the correct notation for common fractions.
- Children can explain the role of the numerator and denominator.
