Literacy

- Please continue to follow the instructions inside your child's Literacy homework jotter for spelling homework. Please contact me if you have any queries regarding the tasks assigned.
- Your child should also regularly revise the previous common word sets, as well as the previous phonemes.
- Your child should read at home for at least 20 minutes every day.
- Please also remember to use the IDL Spelling app at least 3-4 times per week (complete 1-2 lessons per session).

Numeracy

Please help your child to become secure and confident with the 3, 4 and 6 times table facts. Your child should be able to recite these times tables, in order and from memory, at a quick pace. They should also be able to answer individual multiplication questions quickly in and out of order e.g. $6 \times 4 = ?$, $3 \times 7 = ?$

Please also remember to use the Sumdog Maths app at least 3-4 times per week.

Interdisciplinary Learning: Solo Talk

All Primary 4 pupils are asked to plan for a solo talk at the start of June. Children are asked to select a topic of interest and research it.
