


Focus for Learning

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Numeracy and Maths

This term we will be looking at;


-Learning to round to the nearest 10 or 100 using numbers with up to 4 digits and in some cases decimal numbers.

-Number- order and place value

- Reading and writing whole numbers**
- Comparing and ordering numbers**
- Partitioning numbers up to five digits**

-Number; including addition and subtraction using mental and written strategies.

- Number ; multiplication and division- recalling multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10.

Our focus for this term is:
