Primary 4-5

Language

- Our Writing will be focussed on narrative, persuasive and explanation texts.**
- We will link our writing to Media, Celebrations and Science.**
- We will be reading graphic novels.**
- We will be exploring aspects of Media such as colour, camera angles, characters, setting and sound.**
- We will be writing our own scripts linked to Christmas and using these as the basis for drama experiences.**



Our focus for Talking and Listening will be:

- Making notes from Movie clips and using these to inform our own scripts.**
- Working collaboratively taking turns to speak and developing confidence when sharing and deciding on ideas.**

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Numeracy and Maths

This term we will continue to revise key concepts such as time, measure and mental agility.

The children will be learning to :

Add and subtract larger numbers using a range of strategies including partitioning, number lines and column sums.

Solve and represent multi– step word problems.


Link multiplication and division facts to solve equations.

Find fractions such as three-quarters of 16, two-thirds of 9 etc.

Match equivalent fractions $2/4 = 1/2$

Match fractions to make a whole.

Order fractions.
