## Christmas

Unfortunately we are unable to have groups of parents in the building due to COVID restrictions. This means that we cannot have a Christmas show again this year. Each class will film a small performance and this will be shared with parents. In addition we are hoping to live stream a carol concert. Details will be issued nearer the time.

We are able to bring groups of children together so this means our Christmas Fun Day can go ahead. Each class will set up stalls with items to buy or activities they can participate in e.g. Hook a duck, knock down the cans etc. There will be a number of free activities as well as those which charge a nominal fee. This helps the children understand the concept of money and will help us raise money for school funds.

Last year was a very difficult Christmas for us all and we are determined to make sure this Christmas is magical for our pupils.



## Pantomime

We have booked to go to Robin Hood at Cumbernauld's new Lantern house Theatre on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> of December. The school will be subsidising the cost however it will still work out at £10 per child. If you have more than three children at the school there will be a reduction. ## COP26

Many of our classes are involved in producing a workshop presentation as part of the planned COP26 gathering in Glasgow later this year. P4/5 are looking at the impact of plastic on our environment, P5/6 will be looking at deforestation and P7 are investigating climate change and the increasing number of natural disasters. All classes will work together to produce a presentation entitled See Our World – the impact of humans on Nature. This will be shared with our wider school community when finished.



## Charity/School Funds

Following the success of last year, we are once again participating in Strathcarron Hospice Santa Dash event. The majority of funds raised will support the hospice, and some will go to supporting our pupils at Christmas. Sponsorship forms will be sent out in due course.

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> December we will be participating in Clyde 1's Cash for Kids Christmas jumper day. Children can wear any item of Christmas clothing they want, or just dress down. We are suggesting a donation of £1 per child.

We will also be collecting food items for the local food banks. Children can bring in donations of tins, biscuits, tea, coffee etc and we will hand the items in during the last week of term.

We have a very proud tradition of helping others in St Mary's and we are always amazed by your generosity. This is a value which we know our young children will carry with them throughout their lives and captures the true meaning of Christmas.
