Learning in the nursery

Within the art area of the nursery the children have been involved in a lot of sensory play, they have explored shaving foam with paint and glitter in it. A few children have been mark making with their fingers in it but most children like to squeeze it through their fingers. They have also had the opportunity to mix paint, predicting what colour they will make depending on paints mixed and so have made a variety of colours. The children have all been encouraged to help to make snack, cutting up fruit or spreading butter/jam onto a cracker or bread. They will then independently help themselves to snack. Outdoors most children have had the opportunity to go out a walk, this is a follow up from when they went to see the changes in the environment on their autumn walk. A few children went to the local shop to buy snack food.

We were given a parachute from the school which the children have really enjoyed experiencing. They particularly like lying and running underneath. Mrs Mitchell has been learning Makaton, this is to help all our children in communicating with the staff and each other, she has been teaching the children and staff basic signs. We are going to use some in our Christmas songs this year.

We have a recognition wall in the nursery where the children choose an area that we all need to work on, just now it's being kind and gentle. If staff see anyone achieving this there name is put on the wall.

Weather appropriate clothing

If you could please make sure your child/children are dressed for the weather when coming to nursery. New government policy says that children should be out in all weathers every day. Therefore on

<u>Rainy days</u> they should wear waterproof jackets and trousers (please make sure these say that they are waterproof) and have wellingtons on.

<u>Snow days</u> they should wear warm clothes, hats, gloves, scarves, wellingtons or snow boots, waterproofs or snow suits.

As the weather is changing we also ask if you could look at weather before coming into nursery, and if it is sunny if you could please put on some sun cream for your children. We will be able to top this up during the day.

Nursery fund

We would like to thank parents who have contributed to the nursery fund (yellow envelopes) and appreciate your continued support. These funds are important in enabling us to provide the children with snacks twice daily such as crackers, bread, butter, meat etc. as well as enabling us to buy the children Birthday and Christmas presents and replenish resources. This is a suggested donation of £2.50. Please ask staff for an envelope if you require one.

Safety

Can we please ask all parents to remember to close the gate when entering or leaving the nursery. If the children are outside with a member of staff when you come to collect your child can we ask that you do not open the gate as we need to keep all the children safe who are outdoors. A member of staff will bring your child to you.
