Learning in the Nursery

Thurs 2nd Mar

Within the snack area the children have been helping to prepare snack for their peers, they have been chopping up fruit with knives, counting out food like breadsticks, crackers, biscuits and cups for water/milk. We celebrated Chinese New Year and the children got to try a variety of Chinese food. The house corner also became a Chinese restaurant. They also had the opportunity to make pancakes for pancake day and after snack making playdough.

The children particularly like playing with large floor puzzles and games with some support from staff. In the nursery the children have been interacting with new resources, they were sorting and matching loose parts like beads, sticks, bark, feathers and stones. Children have been counting and beginning to recognise numbers using a variety of media in and out of the nursery. Some have also started to mark make numbers using chalk.

Weather Appropriate Clothing

If you could please make sure your child/children are dressed for the weather when coming to nursery. New government policy says that children should be out in all weathers every day. Therefore on

<u>Rainy days</u> they should wear waterproof jackets and trousers (please make sure these say that they are waterproof) and have wellingtons on.

<u>Snow days</u> they should wear warm clothes, hats, gloves, scarves, wellingtons or snow boots, waterproofs or snow suits.

As the weather is changing we also ask if you could look at weather before coming into nursery, and if it is sunny if you could please put on some sun cream for your children. We will be able to top this up during the day.

Nursery Fund
