Learning in the nursery

We have been very lucky to have Joan supporting us in nursery a very experienced equity and excellence lead. She has been supporting children with pedalling on the bikes especially those who are very good at the balance bikes. The children are developing in confidence whilst doing this.

The children have been learning a new snack routine that encourages their independence from preparing snack, putting numbers out of how many items allowed, telling peers snack is open, after having snack they are washing their dishes.

In the art area the children have been selecting what experiences they wish to be involved in. This has been gluing, painting, doing symmetry pictures, using brushes, cotton wool, cotton buds and sponges.

There has been a lot of interest in water play within the art room and outdoors. They have been washing dolls, playing with pom poms, bubbles, slime. Outdoors they have been transporting the water from area to area making chocolate cake, soup and tea for their peers and the ladies.

When the children are outside with a member of staff when you come to collect your child, can we ask that you do not open the gate as we need to keep all the children safe that are outdoors. A member of staff will bring your child to you.
