French The Perfect Tense Avoir Verbs

The Perfect Tense in French is made up of two elements:

- 1. The Auxiliary verb (Avoir or Etre)
- 2. The Past Participle

Avoir:

J'ai Nous avons
Tu as Vous avez
Il a Ils ont
Elle a Elles ont

The Past Participle is formed as follows:

ER verbs – remove the ER and add 'é', e.g.

Donner (to give) = donné (given) Regarder (to watch) = regardé (watched)

IR verbs – remove the IR and add 'i', e.g.

Finir (to finish) = fini (finished)
Choisir (to choose) = choisi (chosen)

RE verbs – remove the RE and add 'u', e.g.

Vendre (to sell) = vendu (sold) Perdre (to lose) = perdu (lost)

So the perfect tense of donner is:

J'ai donné = I have given OR I gave

Tu as donné = You have given OR you gave

And finir:

J'ai fini = I have finished OR I finished
II a fini = He has finished OR he finished

And vendre:

Nous avons vendu = We have sold OR we sold Ils ont vendu = They have sold OR they sold
