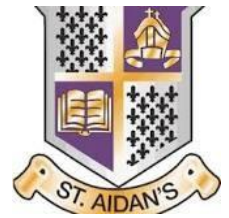


St Aidan's Primary, LCSC and Nursery class



**Our child friendly guide to a
safe return to our school and
nursery**



After many months of our school building being closed, pupils will finally return in August. The school staff have been working very hard to make sure it is as safe as possible for our school family.



We know some of you may not have been able to do all of the tasks your teacher set for you at home. Don't worry about this, we understand.

You may not have spoken to or seen any of your friends in a long time. It is normal to feel a bit nervous about seeing them again. We will support you and your friends as you return to your classes.



Our school and nursery had to close to stop the spread of something called Coronavirus. It can also be called Covid-19.



Coronavirus can make you feel unwell, a little bit like having a cold or the flu. Coronavirus can give you:

A high temperature



A continuous cough



Loss or change of smell and taste

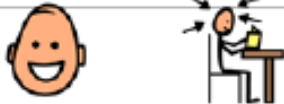


Please remember that if you do have a fever, cough or lose your sense of smell, it does not mean that you definitely have Covid-19. It can mean that you have a common cold. Only a doctor can tell you if you have had or have Covid-19.

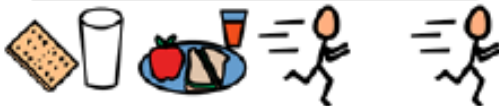
My teacher and all the staff will be so happy to see me and I will be learning lots of new things

We have to make sure that we keep safe by displaying social distance. The virus can live on our hands so we will have to wash them lots during the day. To kill all germs, we have to wash our hands for 20 seconds. If you sing happy birthday twice, that's how long it should take.

There will be other times when we can rub hand gel on our hands to keep us safe.



If you blow your nose, do it in a tissue and put it straight in the bin. Then, wash your hands or use hand gel.



If you cough or sneeze and don't have a tissue, do it in your sleeve. Then, wash your hands or use hand gel.

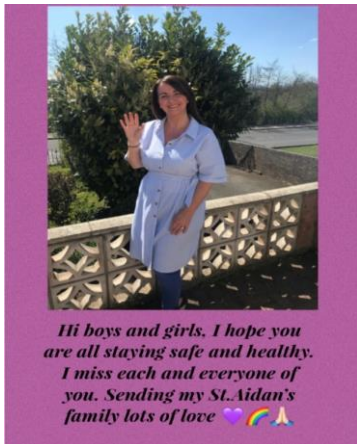


Try not to not to touch your face as germs can spread from your hands to your mouth.

Our school/nursery make look a little different but it should feel the same... A place where you feel happy and safe.

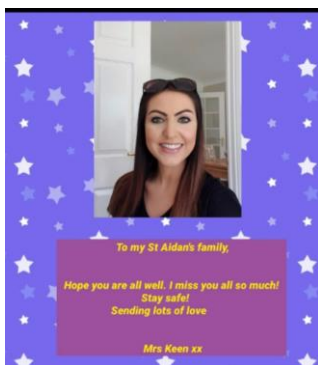

Meet Mrs Duffy – P4 Class Teacher



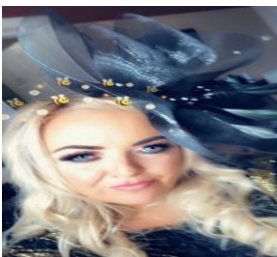
