Zones and Important Times

When entering/exiting the school, you should use the gate that represents the zone you are in.

 Start and Finish Times –

 P1, P1/2, P2 and all LCSC –
 8.50 am – 2.50 pm

 P3, P3/4 –
 8.55 am – 2.55 pm


 P4-7 –

Gate 1 – Red Zone 1- P1/ P1/2 P2 – You will also play in this zone (infant area)

Gate 1- Yellow Zone-2 P3 P3/4 and LCSC- You will also play in this zone (Pencils to the woodlands) (although if you have a friend in the P4 yard, you will be able to play with your friend)

Gate 2 – Green Zone 3- P4, P5. P5/6– You will also play in this zone (Football pitch/ bottom senior end)

Gate 2 (You can also use Denholm Drive Gate)— Blue Zone P6 and P7 – You will also play in this zone (Senior area – top football pitch (although if you have a friend in the P4, P5, P5/6 yard, you will be able to play with your friend) You can also use Denholm Drive Gate.
