What is syllabification?


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## Syllibification

- Syllabification is a useful strategy to help spell words, it is also a technique used by poets to create rhythm in their poems. They select words which have a specific number of syllables to keep the beat of their poem.
- A syllable is a part of a word that contains sounds (phonemes), all syllables must contain a vowel sound.
- Think of it as a 'beat'. It helps to clap your hands as you say the word!

For example:
boy - 1 syllable

shopp-ing -2 syllables
in-ter-net-3 syllables

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## Syllibification Spelling Task

I changed this from "little" to "red" as I had too many syllables in this sentence.
$\checkmark$ Try clapping it out as you read it, can you count the syllables.
$\checkmark$ Remember a syllable must contain a vowel sound.
$\checkmark$ You can check using the syllable counter but have a go first.
