







Theme 2 – Our learning & Teaching – How easy is it for us to know the progress we are making in school and be able to share this with our parents/carers?


Theme 3 – Our school and community – What do you think of the reputation of our school in the community? What do the local media say about our school? What image of our school is portrayed through social media?
