## Working from Home

Pupils can work from home to maintain their learning through revision and home study tasks. They can use either school materials or access a wide range of online resources. Suggested activities could include:

- ✓ Using ICT supports use sites such as GLOW, Scholar, school website (Parent Page – Supporting Work at Home), BBC Bitesize, or the SQA website to access a variety of materials and learning activities
- ✓ Follow the school and departments on Twitter lots of subject specific resources, activities and links are posted there regularly
- ✓ Reading over course notes, jotters, folios
- ✓ Using textbooks and other materials kept at home
- ✓ Undertaking revision activities of work already covered in class

Accessing GLOW – most pupils are familiar with using GLOW and Microsoft Teams as part of their subject learning. There are also a range of learning sites and activities accessible through GLOW. All pupils have been reminded of their secure GLOW usernames and passwords were reset if required.
