
St Ambrose High School Foodbank Appeal 2022




- First of all, a **massive** thank you to everyone for the support given to the foodbank appeal in the run up to Christmas.

How will the appeal work this time?

- Each year group is asked to bring in as many donations as possible
- Bring your donations directly to your RE teacher
- Your RE teacher will keep a tally of any donations that your class bring in (RE teachers, can you please then bring donations to the RE base)
- A tally will be kept weekly, and announced on your year group teams
- The year group with the most donations at the end of this term (Easter) will be given a reward during their RE time

What can you donate?

- Non-perishable food items such as tinned soups, tinned meats & fish, pasta, rice, tea bags, cereal
- Toiletries such as toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, sanitary products
- Pet products such pet food & treats
- Baby products such as baby food
 & cereal, baby formula, nappies
