





St. Ambrose was born in 339 A.D. (2,361 years ago)


He is the Patron Saint of our school.

#### How do I pay for School Meals?

- You will be issued with a Young Scot Card and you will use this and a unique pin number to pay for your lunch or snacks.
- Your parent / carer should load money onto the card using ipay or you can add coins into the machines in school.





#### How do I find my way around the School?

- There will be a P7 information evening on May 25<sup>th</sup> at 6pm where you
  can visit departments and look around the building (one adult per pupil)
- You will follow a two-day induction Tue 31st May & Wed 1st June
- Your school will be given the opportunity to attend a 'P7 only' school show rehearsal in June. You will be first to see the show!
- You may be invited to attend the summer transition programme.
- For the first week you will have a guide who will take you and your class to each of your lessons and collect you.

## What happens during the Induction Days

- Please arrive at St Ambrose High school for 9:15am (wear your school uniform)
- You will be seated with your tutor class in the assembly hall
- You will have lunch provided for you in the canteen (bring a snack for interval)
- You will experience moving around the school and trying out some subjects with your new classmates.

#### Day 2

- Please arrive at St Ambrose High school for 9:15am (wear PE Kit / sports clothes)
- You will attend a range of subjects in the morning
- You will take part in Potted Sports in the afternoon (variety of sports activities)
- You will have lunch provided for you in the canteen (bring a snack for interval)
- You will finish at 2:45 both days.

#### Top Tips

Always have your timetable with you so you know where you are supposed to be next

Don't be afraid to ask for help if you are lost

You'll get lots of practical help: induction days; being shown around the school; a map of the school; people showing you the way and the routines









Level 1 - looking down to Social Area


