### Term 4 April-June 2017



<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>We will continue to develop The Three Read approach to literacy through reading the stories –The Very hungry Caterpillar, The Enormous Turnip, Jack and the Beanstalk and The Three Bears.</p> <p>We will learn nursery rhymes and songs associated with Spring/Summer, planting/growing and under the sea.</p> <p>We will explore letters and signs in the environment.</p> <p>We will be able to identify our names and we will make positive attempts to write them.</p> <p>We will learn mathematical vocabulary relating to measure.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We will learn the importance of measurement in everyday life.</p> <p>We will read the story The Three Bears and discuss and compare size/height.</p> <p>We will use a range of resources to identify objects that are small medium and large.</p> <p>We will use measuring tools indoors and outdoors to learn about plant growth.</p> <p>We will explore capacity in the water area using measuring resources.</p>
<p><b>Health &amp; Well Being</b></p> <p>We will learn to keep safe in emergency situations.</p> <p>We will know that there are people in our lives who care for and look after us.</p> <p>We will discuss the roles of people who help us at school and in the wider community.</p> <p>We will engage in daily energetic play and participate in the nursery sports day.</p>	<p><b>Our Topic</b></p> <p>We will extend our knowledge and understanding of New life in Spring.</p> <p>We will explore the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears.</p> <p>We will investigate Under the Sea as our Summer theme.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>We will discuss life cycles.</p> <p>We will learn about plants and be able to name the different parts of a plant.</p> <p>We will plant seeds and know how to look after them.</p> <p>We will observe and measure plant growth.</p> <p>We will explore the properties of water and learn about life under the sea.</p> <p>We will identify seasonal changes in the environment.</p>	<p><b>Social Subjects</b></p> <p>We will learn about our school community and the roles of the people who work there.</p> <p>We will participate in Transition visits to our primary 1 classes.</p> <p>We will take part in a Teddy Bears picnic as part of our topic.</p> <p>We will be visited by different people within our school communities to find out how they can help us.</p> <p>We will participate in an educational excursion as part of our early interdisciplinary learning.</p>
<p><b>Technology</b></p> <p>We will use the smartboard to listen to stories and play games to support our understanding of size and measure.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>We will follow the ABC music programme to develop our awareness of creating sounds.</p> <p>We will learn songs associated with Spring/Summer and The Three Bears.</p> <p>We will learn new songs and rhymes for our end of year show.</p>
<p><b>Drama</b></p> <p>We will engage in role play associated with The Three Bears and The Three Bears Cottage.</p> <p>We will learn how to perform for a wider audience as part of our graduation and end of year concert.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>We will explore the Season of Spring and create images of plants and flowers as they grow.</p> <p>We will discuss life under the sea and create displays and images representing what we see.</p>
