| <p>Literacy</p> <p>The children will continue to work on the NLC Active Literacy Spelling and Phonics Stage 3 programme. They will read books appropriate to their level of fluency and understanding. In handwriting and grammar, the children will learn to join letters and how place conjunctions appropriately. The children will work on writing recounts, narratives and reports through the IDL topic – Egyptians.</p> | <p>Maths</p> <p>In maths, the children will work with whole numbers up to 100 and then up to 1000 (count, order, read/write). They will learn about patterns and sequences – even/odd numbers, whole number sequences within 100. They will learn addition and subtraction to 100 and revisit the maths time – telling the time and durations.</p> |
| <p>Health & Wellbeing (including PE)</p> <p>In PE the children are working with Mr Cairns who is developing their striking skills within a games context. They are continuing to develop their multi-cognitive ability; stimulating both sides of the brain simultaneously. The children are being reminded of the importance of safe movement and cooperation within the gym hall setting.</p> | <p>Religious Education</p> <p>In RE, the children will continue to develop their faith where they will learn about the Bible, Liturgical seasons and the importance of God's Prayer. They will also learn about relationships – family and friends through the God's loving plan 'This is your faith' programme.</p> |
| <p>Science</p> <p>The children will be investigating Sun, Moon and Stars through a mini topic 'Space'. They will learn to investigate, predict and record their own science experiment, as well as describe some interesting facts about the sun, moon and stars.</p> | <p>Social Subjects</p> <p>The children will learn about People, Past Events and Society through the topic 'Ancient Egyptians'. A variety of learning outcomes will be covered across social studies, expressive arts, literacy, numeracy, and technologies.</p> |
| <p>Technology</p> <p>The children will revise safe and effective use of a range of ICT equipment this term. They will make use of PowerPoint to create a presentation in line with their topic and will access appropriate websites to research animals of the rainforest.</p> | <p>Music</p> <p>The children will begin using ABC music to explore the concept of rhythm and will explore the instruments from the Percussion section of the orchestra.</p> |
| <p>Drama</p> <p>The children will learn about Voice & Movement through a variety of Drama Circle games. They will use some of the Drama conventions – flashback and hot seating through the Egyptian theme.</p> | <p>Art</p> <p>The children will be working with Mrs McMichael during term 1, where they will explore primary colours and the colour wheel. Throughout the term they will create art pieces relating to their Egyptian topic.</p> |
| <p>Homework Projects</p> <p>Homework is distributed on a Monday morning and returned on a Thursday. For children to improve their fluency in Literacy and Numeracy, it is important that time is taken at home to support pupils learning. Please ensure your child brings their reading book and diaries to school every day.</p> | |
