Literacy	Maths
<p>We will develop the Three Read approach to literacy through reading a range of stories.</p> <p>We will learn rhymes and songs associated with Winter, Spring, Farm animals and being healthy.</p> <p>We will develop pre- writing skills across the curriculum.</p> <p>We will explore letters and symbols and we will be able to identify our names.</p> <p>We will create labels and signs for our Healthy eating shop.</p> <p>We will learn vocabulary associated with letters and numbers.</p> <p>We will explore counting rhymes and songs to develop our awareness of number quantities.</p>	<p>We will focus on Number and learn how to touch count and move objects to develop an awareness of 'How Many.'</p> <p>We will engage in a wide range of counting activities including registration and snack time.</p> <p>We will learn number names and be able to match numbers to quantities.</p> <p>We will start to put numbers in order.</p> <p>We will explore number in the outdoor environment by counting out resources and natural objects.</p> <p>We will explore money as part of our role play.</p> <p>We will learn about size and relate to our Animal/Spring topic.</p>

<p>We will learn about Healthy foods and know why certain foods are healthy or unhealthy.</p> <p>We will discuss and taste different types of foods.</p> <p>We will explore Sid & Shanarri resources to further develop our understanding of being healthy.</p> <p>We will learn about food hygiene and why it is important.</p> <p>We will engage in energetic activities using the active families programme.</p> <p>We will participate in our Little Chef Big Chef healthy eating workshops.</p>	<p>We will focus on the season of Winter and discuss Winter weather in Scotland and in different parts of the world.</p> <p>We will explore healthy eating as part of our Healthy Me topic.</p> <p>We will examine seasonal change from Winter to Spring.</p> <p>We will discuss new life in Spring and relate to our outdoor environment.</p> <p>We will learn about farm animals and life on the farm.</p>
Science	Social Subjects
<p>We will experience Winter weather and record Winter temperatures.</p> <p>We will explore water and ice.</p> <p>We will discuss the effects of Winter weather.</p> <p>We will learn vocabulary associated with Winter and Spring.</p> <p>We will investigate plant growth indoors and outdoors.</p> <p>We will learn about animals and discuss animal habitats.</p> <p>We will investigate electricity and how it works.</p> <p>We will explore simple forces and sounds.</p>	<p>We will examine the past as we explore old toys and new toys.</p> <p>We will compare old and new toys and participate in our Bring a toy to nursery day.</p> <p>We will explore seasonal change as we investigate Winter weather and identify signs of Spring.</p>

<p>We will use the smartboard to engage in interactive play.</p> <p>We will use a range of construction materials to create 3D models and structures.</p>	<p>We will be introduced to Spanish songs through the ABC music programme.</p> <p>We will explore sound through play.</p>
