School Improvement Plan



We are always aiming for excellence for the children in St. Andrew's. Last year we had a particularly successful year with many positive changes affecting learning and opportunities for all children. Our School Improvement Report reflecting these successes is available on our school webpage as well as this year's School Improvement Plan.

This year we will make every effort:

- > To further improve attainment in numeracy/mathematics while improving digital literacy.
- > To improve attainment in literacy and English with clear processes for assessment, moderation, monitoring and tracking in writing.
- > To improve attainment and achievement via Health and Well Being.
- To focus on the Religious theme of developing as a community of faith and learning.

St. Andrew's Primary has been designated as one of North Lanarkshire's 35 'Keys to Success' schools and so gains targeted improvement support in addition to the universal Scottish Attainment Challenge funding. We have also been allocated 1.0fte class teacher additionally to support CANcan targeted interventions. Our School Improvement Plan has been constructed to include targets and uses for these extra funds and resources.
