Careers advisers **Shona Thomas** and **Mhairi Teasdale** are based in the library within the school and deliver the following services to school pupils:

S1 – introductory class talk given to all pupils in class, focusing on increasing awareness of self and opportunities;

S2 – subject choice class talk and one-to-one subject choice interview for all pupils;

S3 – class talk on future job trends;

S4 – class talk on opportunities after S4; option to receive a guidance interview with a careers adviser;

S5 – assembly talk on opportunities after S5; option to receive a guidance interview with a careers adviser;

S6 – assembly talk on opportunities after S6; option to receive a guidance interview with a careers adviser.

All pupils from S1-S6 can attend a lunch-time drop-in on Tuesdays in the school library from 12.55pm, where they can come to ask questions about their career ideas.
