## Senior Phase SQA Update

### **National 3&4:**

Those learners aspiring to achieve awards at National 3 and National 4 level are working through coursework and assessments in classes. Great attendance and a great work ethic are so important to achieve success in these qualifications as the assessment is ongoing throughout the year. It's important to remember that the majority of learners who achieve National 4 qualifications in Fourth Year achieve great results at national 5 at the end of Fifth Year. Many will then go on to achieve the 'GOLD' standard Higher award joining the 60% of our learners who achieve a higher before they leave.

### **National 5:**

As you know, there are no National 5 external exams this session with Teacher Professional Judgements forming the estimate grades which will be used by the SQA to decide on final awards. Each subject is preparing learners to provide strong key assessment evidence. Some of this evidence will be overtaken during the fourth year 'prelim' assessment fortnight week beginning Monday 30th November. For those taking N5 in S5/6, this will be in late January. Full reports for Fourth Year will follow in late January/early February. The message from teachers is maintain your focus to complete course work well and revise properly for assessments now and enjoy a break at Christmas.

### **Higher & Advanced Higher:**

Higher and Advanced Higher examinations are planned for May/June 2021 and a prelim diet of exams is being planned week beginning Monday 21st January. One thing we have learnt recently however is that the ongoing classwork and assessment is crucial to success in these exams in particular as we navigate through the pandemic. The clear message is : Complete coursework well and don't wait to begin study and revision until the prelims. Work hard now and you will reap the rewards in good results later.






# COVID 19

**Here's a wee reminder of what is in place at St Andrew's to mitigate the risk of the spread of the virus.**

- Our Pink and Green weeks provide longer teaching blocks which reduces the need for movement about the school significantly.
- Hand hygiene routines are well established on entry to the building and in each teaching area.
- Teachers and staff maintain 2 metre social distancing and wear face coverings as appropriate.
- At the start of the day, morning interval and lunchtime—S1&2 are in the social area/ S3 the assembly hall / S4 & 5 in separate halves of the games hall and S6 in the Gym hall to accommodate social distancing and reduce mixing amongst year groups.
- S4-6 wear masks at all times in the school building unless eating. Please ensure that learners have their face covering with them in the morning. We do provide masks for those who don't have one. However this can be costly and time consuming.
- S1-3 wear masks when moving through corridors and during breaks when in the building and not eating. All learners can wear masks when they wish
- Our cleaners are working very hard with the enhanced cleaning regime and we use TOUCAN spray which is harmless to the environment and super effective at killing COVID19.
- If anyone in the household displays symptoms please follow the advice and let the school know of the need to isolate as soon as you can. We will contact you to ensure



- Lunch and interval queues are busy but well managed. Those learners who use the FUSION app to pre-order their food jump to the front of the queues which really helps to make service go much more quickly so that everyone is happy.

All students are encouraged to download the Satchel One, Teams, OneDrive & Outlook apps onto their phones. (They can also download other MS Office apps).


Parents & children can also download the FUSION App to beat cafeteria queues.
