SNACKS/LUNCH

OUTDOOR LEARNING

Where possible, our children will spend time outdoors exploring their local area. The current outdoor space allocated for use will be risk assessed before undertaking any outdoor play. We are currently awaiting outdoor play equipment and wet weather suits to ensure we have as much fun outside as possible.

ROUTINES

St. Augustine's Nursery Class is committed to ensuring that children attending our nursery provision have time to settle into their new environment. Our initial priority is their emotional wellbeing and our staff will be spending lots of time continuing to know your child to ensure they feel safe and secure in their new setting. We will be providing lots of learning experiences and will encourage free play to let your child settle in and become more confident in their learning environment. In time, our staff will be carrying out observations of all the children to help us plan a range of learning experiences to meet their individual needs and interests and we will shortly be contacting you to discuss your child's Personal Learning Plan.

ICT

Children will have the use of I-pads in our Nursery and will be encouraged to develop skills in technology. Due to COVID 19 there has been a delay in the arrival of our ICT equipment, but we have been assured children will have the use of these soon. We are currenty waiting on a lare interactive whiteboard for the nursery room.

FACILITIES

The staff will accompany all children to and from the toilet, and support them if necessary, ensuring they comply with Health Protection Scotland guidance for hygiene etc. whilst encouraging independence skills. Good hygiene practices will be encouraged and hand sanitiser will be available to children at all times.

NURSERY FUND

Each week we will collect £2.50 for nursery/toy fund. The money will be used to buy toys, provide opportunities for celebrations, Christmas party and fun days. Toy fund is a voluntary donation to help support the nursery.
