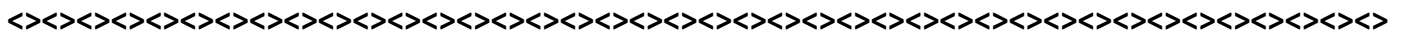
Class pages on the school website provide parents and carers with regular information on their child's learning, in addition to DOJO story.
