Dear Parents/Carers,

As we come to the end of our first term, I am delighted at how well the children particularly our Primary 1 children have settled into school life. Next term is looking very busy and we want to take this opportunity to share with you some important information for the month ahead.

<u>Weather</u>

The days are much colder and although our school is very cosy, the children will still be playing outside, weather permitting so they need to be well wrapped up. Please ensure your child is suitably dressed for this weather. For their comfort they also need to have a pair of indoor shoes (gym shoes) to change into in class. Please check your child has softer indoor shoes that still fit.

School Security

The safety and security of your children is our priority at all times, the following school procedures are in place to ensure the safety of your children.

- Latecoming please encourage your child to come to the school office if they are late even if only by a few minutes, your child could be marked off on the register and an absence text sent out, this can be distressing to the parent.
- School Bus we now have 33 children entitled to school transport, we ask you to complete the transport slip given out on Friday and return to office on Monday, this is a great help to our staff who everyday ensure your child is where they should be at 3.00pm.
- Clydesdale After School Club please contact CASC and school by 2pm if you have a change to your arrangements, there sometimes can be confusion and young children are not always sure of where they are going.
