Summer Show

Tickets will be on sale at the school office only from Thursday 6th June and will be restricted to <u>one</u> <u>per family for each performance</u> to allow all our families to be accommodated. Tickets are £3 per adult (age 12 and over) and £1.50 per child if they are primary school age. Younger children (age 1 to 5) are able to sit on their parent's knee at no additional cost. Please order so we can be sure that every family has their ticket allowance before offering remaining tickets on a first come first served basis. <u>Tickets must be bought and paid for no later than Thursday 13th June</u>. <u>If you have not purchased your allocated tickets by 13/06/19</u>, they will be sold.
