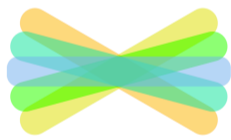
Weekly Learning Grids

Seesaw

Seesaw is our most established platform for sharing learning in class and at home. Children can access and upload to Seesaw by scanning their unique QR code. Microsoft Teams

Microsoft Teams is a digital classroom. Children in P5 to P7 should check in with their class Teams page each day. Children can log in through [Glow](#) or through the Teams app with a Glow email address. Guidance for learners about using Teams can be found [here](#).
