Early indications suggest that this has helped connectivity by taking the pressure off Glow.

Nursery Applications

If your child will be three on or before 28th February 2022 then they are entitled to a funded nursery place after their third birthday from August 2021.

Please note the DEADLINE DATE for application forms to be returned is the <u>12th February 2021</u>, any application forms received after this date will be considered late and will be dealt with once all on time application forms have been placed.
