### The Little Explorers Room

In the Little Explorers Room the staff will begin supporting some children with transition into the 3-5 environment. We have also been welcoming some new children into the nursery and helping them settle in. We have been working on our language development through language rich experiences e.g. stories, rhymes, singing, table top games and messy experiences. We have also been working on our sharing and turn taking skills with our peers. Some children are learning about self-help- skills and learning to use the toilet. The children have also been enjoying their outdoor environment using their bodies to run in large open spaces.

#### The Little Adventurers Room

The Little Adventurers have been learning about people who work in the community, the roles they play and how they can help us. We will be visiting places of work and learning about the services they provide as well as inviting members of the workforce into the nursery e.g. police officers and fire fighters. The children will also be learning about patterns and will have opportunities to explore them in their environment. Another focus of learning this month is to develop the children's writing skills. They will have lots of opportunities to use a variety of writing tools to copy and write words.
