



Spelling Strategies

Use of Phonics

Breaking the word up into different sounds - single and phoneme.

Sullabification

Breaking the word into syllables. Each syllable will contain a vowel.

Words Within Words

Finding a word you already know inside the new word. Compound Words

Splitting the word into two words you already know.

Using what you already know about another word to help you spell a new one (i.e. bright, night, light)

Using a memory aid you already know or have made up yourself (i.e. could - oh you lucky duck) Spelling Rules

Using the one of the Spelling Rules we have covered in

Diacritical Marking

Single sounds/phonemes are marked with a dot under the sound, like so: faster

Joined phonemes are marked by underlining with a dark line, like so:
