Cycling to Nursery Policy

- Here at St Brendan's Nursery children are encouraged to bring their bikes, scooters or even walk to the nursery on a daily basis, promoting health and fitness and reducing their carbon footprint
- The nursery will provide a suitable and safe area for bikes and scooters to be stored while children attend their nursery session. This is located at the main school entrance
- Parents/carers are responsible for their child's safety while riding bikes/scooters into the campus and to designated cycle rack area
- Parents/carers will ensure children are supervised at all times while on bikes/scooters
- Parent/carers have responsibility to ensure bikes/scooters are parked appropriately, safely and securely at all times
- Children will not be permitted to use their own bikes/scooters during a nursery session
- Should parents/carers have any concerns re the use of cycle racks they should bring it to the attention of the nursery staff
- The nursery will not be responsible for any loss or damage to bikes/scooters and parents are advised that they are leaving them at their own risk
