Dress Code Policy

"Within St Brendan's Nursery both adults and children should wear clothing which allows them to participate in all experiences within the nursery"

Staff

- Be professional
- Clothing should not be revealing or restricting
- No offensive slogans or football colours
- Appropriate footwear i.e. not too high
- All staff members should wear clothes that allow them to participate in messy play
- Staff uniforms are provided but are not compulsory

Children

- St Brendan's Nursery stresses how important it is that all children are dressed appropriately when coming to nursery. This is to ensure that all children can participate fully and safely in messy and physical play.

We ask parents/carers to donate uniforms if their child has moved onto school or are too small. These uniforms are accessible to parent/carers at any time and are displayed in the baskets in the corridor.

Uniforms are available to purchase for staff and children from our local supplier. Please ask a member of staff for more information.

Excessive jewellery is NOT APPROPRIATE for either staff or children.

Protective Clothing

- Protective clothing is available in the nursery for both staff and children i.e. aprons, jackets, wellies (own), waterproof suits and sun hats.
- Staff will assess the need of protective clothing for each learning experience
- Ongoing risk assessments will also cover the appropriateness of staff and children's clothing to each learning experience
