Primary 7 Transition Amended Programme

I am writing to you with some information about our amended transition programme. Moreover, my colleagues are adapting some of the learning experiences that they had planned and we hope to be able to engage your child in them online.

Working with our Primary 7 pupils, their families and teachers is always the highlight of my year. While I am disappointed for you and your child that this rite of passage has been disrupted, I am confident that we will be able to celebrate the success of their unique transition to secondary school throughout the coming years.
