ENROLMENTS

Enrolling our new Primary 1 children for Aug 2019 is
an exciting time in the school. Mrs Kelly,
Miss McElhinney and Miss Gillooly will be on hand to
enrol children and we would like to invite all families
with children who are 5 years old between 1/3/19 and
28/2/20 to pop into the school to enrol for the new
session at the following times:

MON 14TH JANUARY FROM 1-3PM

TUES 15TH JANUARY FROM 9-11AM

WED 16TH JANUARY FROM 1-3PM

THURS 17TH JANUARY FROM 9-11AM

If these times are unsuitable, please contact the
school where we will be happy to make other
arrangements.

Please bring your child's birth certificate, a council tax
statement with your address and your child's
Baptismal Certificate if they have one. After
completing the paperwork—don't rush away, as our
Primary 7 children will take you on a tour of the
school!

ADVERSE WEATHER PLANS—A REMINDER

Hopefully we will get through another winter without
being overly affected by snowy weather.

However if Mother Nature sends heavy blizzards our
way and this results in a school closure the following
action will be taken:

- We will inform you by text in the first instance
to let you know this has been decided in the
interests of health and safety
- Staff will remain in school with the children
until they have all been safely picked up

In the event that there has been a heavy snowfall
during the night, you should consult the North
Lanarkshire Council website on:

www.northlanarkshire.gov.uk

prior to embarking on the journey to school. Similarly
if there has been a school closure the website will
inform you if the school is open again.

Class Teachers will post details of tasks and websites
on the school web page to enable children to
continue their learning at home.

ACCESSING THE SCHOOL: During icy weather, when
the ground is slippery, the school is required to keep
one path of access gritted. This will be the pathway
through the Primary 7 Playground which will be
gritted from the gate, to the Main Entrance.

Where possible, there will be a pathway gritted from
the Primary 3 playground to the Nursery and from
the Primary 1 gate to the P1 Area Doors.

If the playground remains icy at the end of the day,
children will be dismissed as follows:

Primary 4b) to Primary 7—exit through the P7 Area
Doors

The Primary 1 to Primary 4a) will exit as normal
through their area doors where pathways will be
gritted. If this is not the case you will be informed of
alternative arrangements.

**Please inform Grandparents and other family
members who may bring your children to school of
these arrangements as the playground at both sides
of the school building is always particularly icy.**

CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY

St Helen's Primary will host Christmas Jumper Day on **Tuesday 18th December** as all funds raised will be donated to MISSIO.

In addition to this day, children are also invited to wear their school uniforms with Christmas jumpers on the following dates:
