to say....



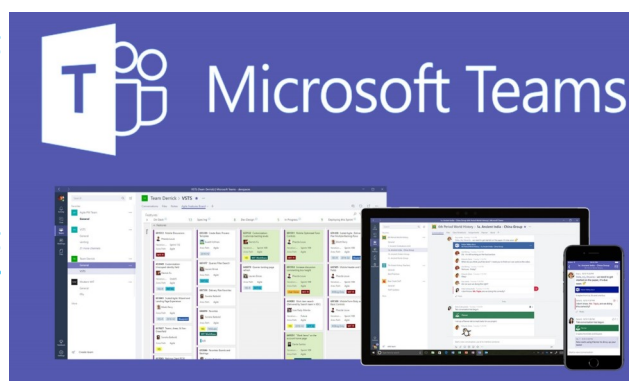

We will work through the migration to Teams TOGETHER! This form of Learning & Teaching is new.



It will take a period of adjustment and so Teachers will keep you updated on GLOW and direct you to Teams for the next week or so, until we are confident that everyone is aware of this new way of working.

# WORK OUT THE BEST TIMETABLE FOR YOU AND YOUR FAMILY!

For many reasons, you may not be able to do every task, every day. This is totally understandable and parents should not feel pressured to do so. No family is in the position to replicate the school day and there is no expectation from the school for you to do that. The Teachers are doing their best to support learning and provide stimulating and appropriate tasks.

We do want you to continue to encourage your child or children to do their best to engage with learning opportunities. There is no pressure to POST TASKS online. However, it is a nice thing when Teachers and Children can interact sometimes through the class posts and through other chats, where you have the means to do this.



We know that there are lots of passwords to remember. However, please do not panic if you forget any. Simply contact your child's Class Teacher on Teams, or call, email, message the school and one of use will get back to you. You can message use through Twitter, Facebook, the School App, Groupcall (by replying to a text from us) or through Parents' Portal. ***We know passwords are probably one of the most stressful things to keep on top of, so try and save them in your settings.***
