- > Helping to make meals

Literacy Activities

In nursery, children experience a wide range of activities to support their language and literacy skills.

➤ Read a story – talk about the characters in the story, how the characters might be feeling, what happens in the story, make predictions i.e. what do you think will happen next? Encourage discussions.

Kaligo is a digital handwriting exercise book designed to teach children how to write using a stylus and tablet, built on an Al machine learning platform. A self-paced approach enables children to progress at their own speed eccording to their own ability, whilst Al Machine learning provides real-time corrective feedback.

Mark Making

- > Give your child some paper and a variety of writing materials i.e. pens, pencils, crayons.
- Write your child's name using a light colour, encourage your child to overwrite or copy.

Numeracy Activities

Numeracy skills can be explored everywhere;

Number, money & measure:

- Singing number songs and rhymes
- ➤ Going on a number hunt around the environment cupboards, clocks, coins, car registrations
- Counting up and down when climbing the stairs
- > Count objects around the house could introduce adding and taking away i.e. 'If I add 2, how many will I have?'
- > Group items into quantity i.e. put the amount of cotton wool balls next to the corresponding number.
- ➤ Introduce a range of coins talk about the value, shape, colour.
- > Use everyday items to measure i.e. how many hands/feet/spoons length is the table?
- ➤ Water play a range of containers use language such as full, empty.
- > Go on a pattern hunt around the environment.

Information Handling:

- Sort and match socks
- ➤ Collect items from the garden sort/order into size, colour, type.
- > Helping to sort the washing
- > Create a chart record the weather daily, patterns on your socks etc.

Shape, position & movement:

- > Go on a shape hunt
- ➤ I spy colour, shape, description i.e. I spy something beside/next to/underneath/on top...
