Make flashcards of the alphabet & put them in alphabetical order. Can you find an object to match each letter?

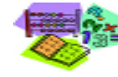
Write a story with the title 'A Wintery Day.' Have something exciting happen in your story. Using your last set of common words, write 4 'silly' sentences containing these words.
