Literacy

Strategy 4 – Inference
Strategy 5 – Main ideas
Strategy 6 – Paraphrasing and summarising
Try to think of as many 'snow' related words as you can and record these on lined paper. Then try to write a perfect paragraph using these words. Remember to meet the core language targets.

Write an imaginative story about a snow day. Remember to include lots of description, adjectives and keep your reader interested. Create an acrostic poem using the words 'Winter Wonderland.'

Complete complements to 100 worksheet.

Make up your own sums on squared paper.

Create 5 numbers that are divisible by 3 of the following numbers:-

2 3 4 5 6 9 or 10

Can you create 5 numbers that are divisible by all numbers?

Make a maths board game with a winter theme.

Interdisciplinary Learning



Create a winter scrap book tracking the changes in weather. Illustrate through diagrams, newspaper cut outs, weather reports from the television or radio. Research a country of your choosing and make a poster with some of the interesting facts that you have found. Create a winter workout – how can you keep fit in the snow? Create a healthy recipe for a winter snack/meal. Ask an adult to help you make it. Make a poster/leaflet on keeping safe in winter.
