Dear Parent/Guardian,

A very warm welcome back to everyone to a new academic year at St. Mary's Primary School and Nursery. I hope you had a pleasant summer holiday! I especially wish to extend a warm welcome to all our new children and their families who have joined the Nursery, Primary 1 and to other stages across the school Please find below information which I hope you find useful.

Pupil Attendance

If your child is absent due to illness we ask if you could do the following:

- 1. On the morning when the absence starts please telephone the school on 274955 to inform us.
- 2. When your child returns to school please send a signed letter explaining the reason for your child's absence.
- 3. If an absence is not reported we will send a text message to alert you to your child's absence. Please acknowledge this message by calling the school.
- 4. If no contact is made the office will call to establish the reason for the child's absence.

If we are unable to make contact to establish why the child is absent we will need to record the child as missing and contact the police.

It is also important that your child **arrives on time** for school at 9.00a.m. Again, this is monitored and we encourage parents to form good habits so that your child starts his/her day in a calm manner.

<u>Kilbowie</u>

The P7 children will go on their residential visit to Kilbowie between Monday 16th and Friday 20th September. A meeting is arranged for Tuesday the 27th August at 6:30 pm in the school to share information. Please note that the children have 2 methods of paying - by cash to the school office and also online payment.

Parking & Gate

A number of parents have again contacted me with concerns around the parking at the school. Can I please remind you not to park on the yellow zig-zag lines. These areas should be kept clear for the safety of the children as they make their way to and from school.

There were also concerns raised that children are finding it difficult to get through the gates, particularly at the end of the day.

Please leave space at the gate to allow children to pass through the gates.

Allergies

NO NUTS!

We have children in school who have a range of medical conditions and some are of a severe allergic nature. We ask that you do not give your child any products containing nuts, this includes

Nutella, peanut butter and chocolate spread.

Please also refrain from sending in a birthday cake, sweets etc. on your child's special day as some of the

children cannot share in this.

We appreciate your co-operation and support in this sensitive and important matter of child safety and in ensuring that no child is made to feel excluded.

Free School Meal Entitlement

Could I remind parents that if you are in receipt of any of the following you will be entitled to a free school meal and/or a clothing grant:

- Income support
- Jobseeker's allowance (income based)
- Employment & support allowance (income related)
- Universal credit (maximum monthly income of £610)
- Child tax credit with a gross annual income below £16,105 with no element of working tax credit
- Maximum child tax credit and maximum working tax credit with annual income below £6,900
- Support under part v1 of the immigration and asylum act 1999
- Housing benefit
- Council tax reduction
