Pantomime



As you will be aware from the initial letter this year we will be attending the pantomime on 12th December. This year the children will again attend the afternoon session beginning at 1:15 pm. As a result of this the children will not return to school until approximately 4.30 pm. This means there will be no transport for the children who would normally travel by bus. As such can I ask that you arrange for your child to be collected **from** their classes at 4:30 pm. All children will be brought into the school when they alight from the bus and the class teacher will dismiss the pupils individually to a parent/ carer. I appreciate this may be an inconvenience but I hope you agree it is a worthwhile activity for the children to attend. Can I also ask if you have still to pay part or in full the balance of £6 you do so at your earliest convenience.

National Gathering for parents with children in Catholic Schools.

Xpressions App

You may recall that when I started to communicate by email through Groupcall I mentioned the plan would be to also communicate through a school App. The App is called Groupcall Xpressions and allows you to get updates from the school on your phone or tablet. Following a pilot by some parents we are now able to go live with the Xpressions App for the school. To allow the App to work properly the contact email address and telephone number we have in the school following the data returns must be the one you use for the App. To load the App following these instructions:

Install/Download Groupcall Xpressions App



- 2. Enter the email address you have given to us.
- 3. Enter your mobile number and then click next. This needs to be the mobile number that we have for you.
- 4. You will receive a 6 digit code via SMS (text message). Enter this code on screen and tap Login.
- 5. On the next screen, you will need to create a password.
- 6. Finally you will be asked to set a 4 digit passcode.


