

Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood Draft Policy

May, 2015



Introduction

The Scottish Catholic Education Service has developed *God's Loving Plan* - a revised programme for Relationship Education in primary schools. *God's Loving Plan* is designed to guide teachers on how children can develop healthy attitudes to their bodies and to all human life so that they can form loving relationships, according to God's loving plan for their lives. *God's Loving Plan* is, therefore, the only programme to be used to deliver **Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood Education** in St. Mary's.

Partnership with Parents

During session 2014/15 we worked closely with parents in order to fully inform them of both the **rationale** behind and the **content** of the *God's Loving Plan* programme. We did this via a Curriculum Evening in September 2014, the setting up of a focus group which met in April 2015 and workshops for Primary 6 and 7 parents in May 2015. As a result of this work there is a consensus in place to deliver the programme detailed below.

Further, from session 2015/16 onwards, we will:

- Inform parents of children in Primaries 1-5 via letter about the content of the programme and how to support their children at home.
- Deliver annual workshops for parents of children in Primaries 6 and 7.
- Inform parents of children in Primaries 6 and 7 via letter about the dates when the programme will be delivered.

- All learning and teaching must be appropriate to the age *and* maturity of the children. Therefore, there is scope for adjustments to the Primary 3 programme if school staff and parents feel adjustments are necessary. Primary 3 parents will be consulted on this prior to the programme beginning.
- The school will be sensitive to the views of parents and carers as the first educators of children.
- Teachers will be sensitive to the plurality of forms of family life which are experienced by our children.
