Tips:

- Always have your timetable with you so you know where you are supposed to be next. You will be given your timetable on your first day. If you have a phone, take a photograph of it in case you lose your original copy.

There are lots of people you can ask including your pupil support teacher Miss Cairns, your head of year, Mrs McGee, the office staff or janitors, Julie, the librarian or the senior pupils in the school. You will recognise them by the green braiding on their blazers.
- You'll get lots of practical help too. We normally match some senior pupils with our new S1 classes to act as guides during the first 2 or 3 weeks. They meet you at your classes and show you around the school. We will keep you updated on how this will work for you as soon as we know.
- Feel free to ask these guides lots of questions, they'll remember exactly how you feel!
- Don't expect to remember it all at once, or to know everything on the first day.
