# Role of Learning Support Teacher

Tutoring and class teaching

Working with individuals/ groups. Read, Write Inc, RTIC, IDL, Numeracy Box

Teaching Co-operatively

Supporting the work of the class and subject teachers by targeting assistance in class.

Providing Consultancy Support

Referrals from class teachers/ pupils/ parents. Advising on learning needs.

Providing Specialist Services

Support with assistive technology and ICT development skills. Standardised assessments of learning needs. SQA Additional Assessment Arrangements.

Contributing to Staff Development

In-service courses, Information Sheets, Class Resources/ Adaptations.

## Additional Support Needs

- ► A young person is said to have additional support needs if they need more, or different support to what is normally provided in schools to children of the same age. It doesn't just apply to children who have long-term learning difficulties or disabilities.
- Local and National Policies and Framework to support early identification of needs and ensure the right support at the right time.
- Least intrusive, time limited interventions/ support to promote independence.
- ► GIRFEC planning.
