Dear Parents / Carers,

It has been a very busy time for us over the last few weeks. The children have all settled into nursery life and are learning the routines and nursery golden rules. You may have noticed our kindness tree in the foyer, we use this when children show acts of kindness within the nursery either to their peers, staff or have shown kindness at home. Please keep us informed if you think your child has shown kindness out with nursery and we will add them to our tree. The children have a great sense of pride and achievement when they can put their kindness flower on the tree.



November Topic

We will continue working on the topic 'Shanarri getting it right for every child'. Your child may have already discussed with you our new puppets Sid and Shanarri. These puppets link in with stories relating to the indicators of getting it right for every child, we hope by using these children will become aware of the words and of being safe, healthy, active, nurtured, respected, responsible and included. We have been reading the stories to the children over the last few weeks and introducing them to their rights according to the UN rights of the child. We hope this will encourage the children to be more aware of how people in their lives work to keep them safe and healthy. Along with the Shanarri topic we will be looking at Autumn, focussing on the changes in the environment. The children have been on Autumn walks where they collected leaves and looked at the different shapes and colours. We will be learning about dark and light and introducing the basics of time.

Students

Over the next few weeks we will be welcoming Early Education in Childhood students to our Nursery. Zoe Armitage who is working towards her NC, will be working with us on a Tuesday and Wednesday and Caitlin Picken who is working towards gaining an HNC will be with us every Monday and Friday. Throughout the year we will be working with a number of students from different colleges and universities.

Play on Pedals

Having previously completed a Play on Pedals course, Mrs Donaldson is now qualified to teach children the different stages of riding a bike. Research and studies have shown balance bikes are more beneficial to train children to learn to ride bikes as opposed to using stabilisers. It is suggested if you do not have a balance bike, pedals and stabilisers are taken off your child's current bike. This will allow them to learn to balance before pedalling. The Nursery will be taking this initiative forward and are looking to acquire a number of balance bikes.

Learning bags

Within the foyer there are a number of learning bags. These are in blue rucksacks and contain a number of stories, games and jigsaws. They are a great resource to help you work with your child at home. Please help yourself to one of these bags and just note down in the yellow notebook which bag you have taken. The children thoroughly enjoy using these bags and are great for learning.

Library books



We are hoping to start our Lending Library soon. The children will be given a book to read at home which they can then swap the following week. If you are interested in helping out with this it would be greatly appreciated. Please note that this service cannot be started without parents' support due to staff commitments in the nursery.
