### PARENT INVOLVEMENT AT ST. MICHAEL'S

### HEALTH AND SAFETY



I would like to remind all our parents/carers that **no dogs** should be brought into the school yard.

Please also remember that access to the school and nursery should always be made via the school pathways. No children or adults should enter the staff car park. For safety reasons it is important

that the pupils enter and exit the grounds through the pupil gates. Please ensure

all carers dropping off or collecting your child are aware of this, thank you. This is of extra importance at the moment as we have a lot of extra traffic due to the rewiring work, with vehicles moving in and out the school throughout the day. Please also remember to check your child's hair on a regular basis and treat appropriately where necessary.

# PROCEDURES FOR THE END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

All class teachers take care and make every best effort to release the pupils to a parent or carer at the end of the school day. If a parent or carer has been unexpectedly delayed and is not in the yard pupils are instructed to return to the class teacher and the school building.

We would be grateful that should you see an unaccompanied child, that you return them immediately to the class teacher and not try to contact the parent independently as this can cause undue concern and upset.

Can I also ask that parents and carers stand well back from the doorways to allow all children to be safely dismissed.

Pupils attending after school clubs are notified by the class teacher on that day, however we would also be grateful if you could remind your child in the morning to avoid confusion at 3.00 p.m.

## COMMUNICATION

St. Michael's is very proud of the fantastic reputation it has locally and in North Lanarkshire. We regularly share information our twitter and through our school website and we are always delighted with positive comments.
