Homework and Microsoft Teams



The children have now been issued with homework jotters. All children should now also have access to Microsoft Teams using their Glow username and password. This is where homework will be issued on a weekly basis. Homework can be uploaded into your child's individual Notebook through our Team, where feedback will be provided. More information regarding homework and the use of

Teams will be given at our Parents' information evening this Thursday. If you are unable to attend and have problems accessing the class team, then please let us know.

Reading Books

Reading books will be issued to children on a **Monday** and **Wednesday**. The books sent home will have been read in class that day. We ask that children please return books to school each day as they will be working on these in class daily.



Outdoor Learning & P.E.

We are very lucky in St Michael's to have access to wonderful grounds and a school forest. We will be visiting the forest regularly and when we plan to visit will be communicated via Teams.

Could children please bring in wellies and appropriate outdoor clothing (jogging bottoms, fleece, rain jacket etc.) as this will allow them to be comfortable and enjoy our time outside. (If you wish your child's boots to

remain in school then just let us know to save having to return them each week.)

Our indoor PE days are **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Children should bring all kit in on a Monday and it will be sent home on a Friday. We also have a 30 minute outdoor P.E session each week. An outdoor kit, including joggers, appropriate shoes and a waterproof jacket is required as the weather begins to change.
