<u>Curriculum</u>

Literacy

Maths



We will be focussing on Number and Number Processes in Term 1 to ensure children have a solid foundation of number before focussing on different aspects of maths this year.

Children are encouraged to work on their number sequencing throughout the year. It is extremely important that they keep up their number ordering and sequencing practice at home. This will help during tasks in class such as Number Talks and Mental Maths.

Topic

This term our topic is France and Scotland, comparing the two counties. We will be exploring the difference in the languages and the culture. If you have any resources you are willing to share, we would take great care of them and this would bring the topic to life for the children. Homework
