The infants, including the nursery and P. 1 - 3 pupils, will take part in our Hallowe'en Parade on Thursday $31^{\rm st}$ Oct at 1.30 p.m. within the school. The children can either go home at lunchtime and return in their costumes or they can bring them into school in the morning and



will be helped into them after lunch. If you wish to collect someone else's child, this must be arranged and the school office notified by 30th October. Children who may not wish to dress up are under no obligation to do so. All parents and carers are welcome to come along and enjoy the parade in the school hall. There will be a raffle and any donations towards this would be gratefully received.

AFTERSCHOOL AND LUNCHTIME CLUBS

We are delighted to be able to give our children the opportunity to take part in many different extra-curricular clubs during lunchtimes and after school. Further details will be sent out separately.

P.7 HIGH SCHOOL OPEN EVENING

The first transition event will take place at St Maurice's High School on Wednesday 9th October from 6.00 - 7.00 p.m. The evening will begin with an introduction from key staff who will support your child and an overview of transition events which will take place over the course of the academic year. You will then visit classrooms and hear from subject specialist about the S1 curriculum. P.7 pupils are welcome to attend.

BREAKFAST CLUB



This supervised service is available to all our children from 8.15 a.m. All children must be supervised until they enter the building. Parents should be aware that any children arriving before 8.15 a.m. may not have access to the building until Breakfast Club staff arrive. Please be aware that all children attending must purchase a breakfast. The breakfast consists of cereal, milk and toast. This is

free to pupils who are in Primary 1 to 5 and for pupils in Primary 6 to 7 who receive free school meals. For all other pupils the cost is £1.00 per day with a sliding scale for families of two at £1.50 per day and families of three at £1.80 per day. Children will then be dismissed into the playground at 8.45 a.m.

PARENTS NIGHT THURSDAY 10th OCTOBER

Details have been emailed to parents regarding the process of booking parents' night appointments. One parent/carer slot is allocated per child. Two parental appointments for one child will only be allocated where legal paperwork dictates it. Should you choose to remove your child from school due to a pre booked holiday on this date, we will be unable to provide another appointment in line with the school's priority to improve attendance for all pupils post covid.

There will be new and nearly new uniform available in the hall, please feel free to take any items that you require. We are all very much looking forward to welcoming all parents/carers into St. Michael's.
