CHRISTMAS COFFEE MORNING

Our Christmas Coffee Morning will take place on Friday 29th November at 10.00 a.m.

There will be various stalls including our ever-popular Tombola. Each class will be selling their Christmas Enterprise, our amazing School Choir will perform and there will be our fantastic Christmas Raffle. Tea/coffee and a mince pie are included in the entry fee of £2.00 per person.

SACRAMENTS

Fr. Emmanuel has requested that the parents and carers who wish their child/children to receive the Sacraments this academic year bring the completed form issued earlier this week to Mass this weekend. Mass times are 6.00 p.m. Saturday and 10.00 a.m. Sunday and all the children will have the opportunity to speak with Fr. Emmanuel as they hand in their form.

BREAKFAST CLUB

This supervised service is available to all our children from 8.15 a.m. All children must be supervised until they enter the building. Parents should be aware that any children arriving before 8.15 a.m. may not have access to the building until Breakfast Club staff arrive. Please be aware that all children attending must purchase a breakfast. The breakfast consists of cereal, milk and toast. This is free to pupils who are in Primary 1 to 5 and for pupils in Primary 6 to 7 who receive free school meals. For all other pupils the cost is £1 per day with a sliding scale for families of two at £1.50 per day and families of three at £1.80 per day. Children will then be dismissed into the playground at 8.45 a.m.

STAY AND PLAY/DROP IN SESSIONS

If you have a child under 3, our popular Stay & Play sessions for toddlers have restarted on Fridays from 9.00 until 10.30 a.m.

There is no need to book a place, just come to the main school door.

There is also an opportunity to meet with our Barnardos worker Monica,

on an informal basis, on Wednesday mornings between 9.00 and 10.30 a.m.

COMMUNICATION
