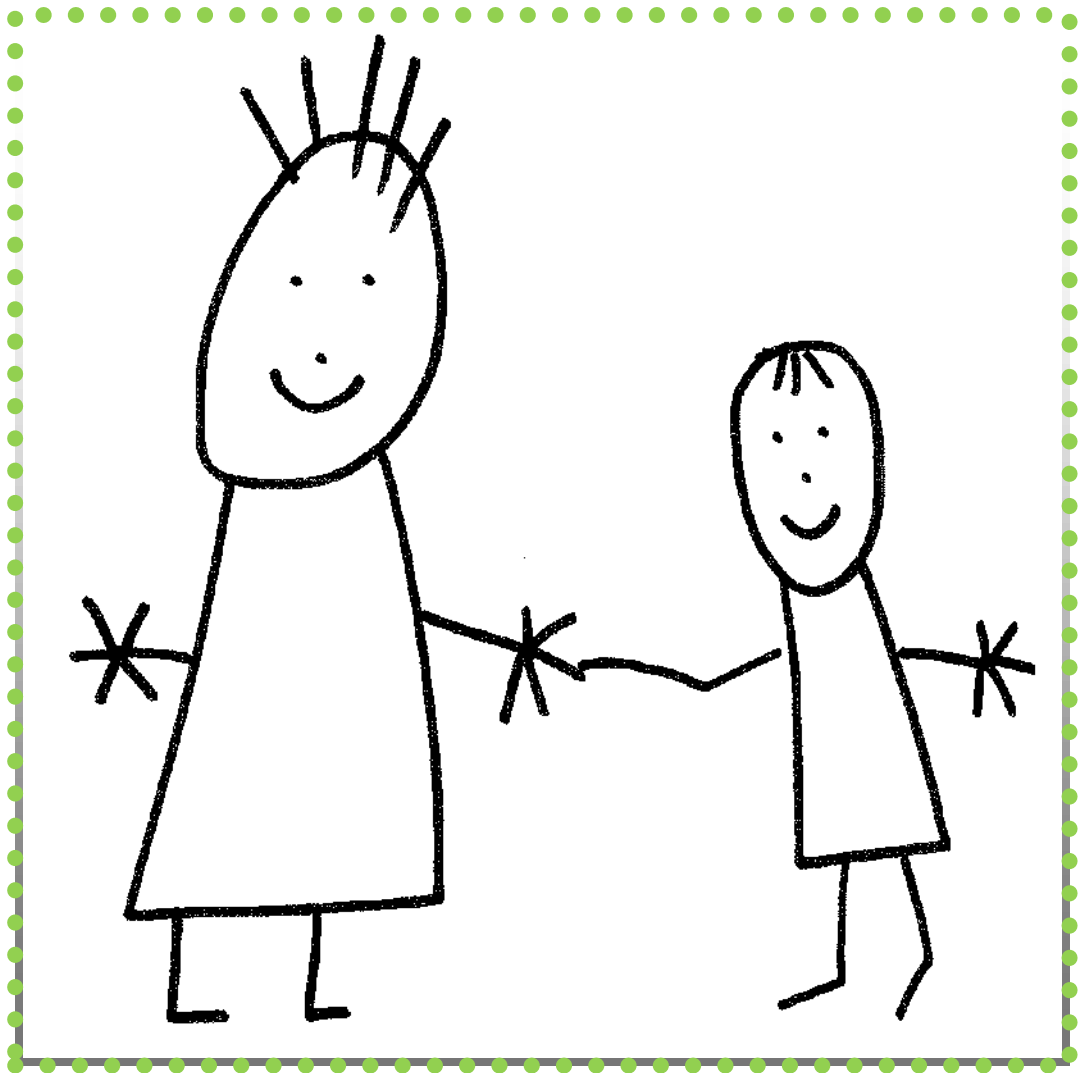

Only adults (people over 16 years of age) may bring and collect children. Please remember to let any adult collecting your child know their specific password and alert staff to any changes.

NURSERY FUND:

A weekly **voluntary** contribution of £2.00 is collected to cover the cost of snacks, baking, parties and small outings, visits from Theatre Groups etc.

Milk is provided at the nursery. If the child does not like milk then water is given instead. Lunch is provided by the school catering service during each session. A hot meal with milk or water will be offered to the children with fruit, yoghurt or a small item of home baking. Parents can be told at the door when collecting their child how much lunch has been eaten.

CELEBRATING BIRTHDAYS:

On your child's birthday you are invited to bring in a small sponge cake to share with the other children. We will provide the rest of the party food from the nursery fund. Birthday cakes should be in a sealed box, bought from a shop.

POINTS TO NOTE

- Children enjoy themselves painting, baking etc. Please let them wear play clothes – not their Sunday Best. They should also have plimsolls or indoor shoes (Velcro fastening if possible).
- Please label all of your child's clothing with their name.
- If you wish, nursery sweatshirts may be purchased from www.logoxpres.co.uk
- Unless there is a medical reason, that staff are made aware of, we expect all children to be toilet trained before starting nursery.
- Please don't allow them to bring in toys from home, as these can get lost or broken.
- Please encourage them to wash their hands before eating.
- If your child is ill please keep them at home, in line with NHS guidance. At this age infections spread very easily.
- We encourage our children to be independent especially at toileting. Please ensure that your child is wearing elasticated trousers/joggers with no difficult buttons and belts.

The following donations are also most welcome:

- Spare socks, pants, jumpers, skirts and trousers so that we can change the children when necessary.

- We want to work in partnership with you. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.
- If you are concerned about your child's happiness or well being please do not hesitate to let us know and we will put things right.
- Encourage your child to come to a member of staff if they feel unhappy.
- Please let us know if your child is going to be absent from the nursery.
